
Please join us in praying for the following:



 sponsors.
- Various research studies are confirming that community parks and recreation, green space and time outdoors is critical for creating healthy, active and sustainable communities.
 You can experience the benefits by connecting with your community parks and recreation any time of the year, and especially on Family Health & Fitness Day — just be sure to be mindful of physical distancing guidelines and guidance from your state and local government and public health officials.

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we realize many of your celebrations will be virtual or


